GAME SYSTEM: Warhammer Age of Sigmar

ARMY SIZE: 2,000 points

LOCATION: Hallam Business Centre, Hallam Street, Stockport, SK2 6PT

ARMY SIZE: 2,000 points

BOARD SIZE: 60" x 44"

MISSIONS: Randomly selected from the Generals Handbook 2021

GAMES: Five games will be played over 2 days

CHOOSING YOUR ARMY: Follow the Battlehost guidelines and restrictions that are listed in the Pitched Battle chart in the Generals Handbook 2021

THINGS TO BRING: You are expected to bring the following with you to the event: your army; dice; a tape measure; all relevant rule books and other publications; at least 6 physical copies of your army list (one to hand in, and one for each of your opponents).

If you are bringing any digital versions of your rules please make sure that you have access to them all throughout the event for reference.

— MUSTERING YOUR ARMY —

YOUR ARMY LIST

Your army can be no more than 2,000 points to play at this event. Follow the Pitched Battles section in the General's Handbook 2021 for details on mustering your army correctly. Any publication released 3 weeks prior to the event can be used, or if it has had FAQ is released at least 7 days before the event. For example:

A new battletome is released, not up for pre-order, on April 2nd - this is valid for use at this event.

A new battletome is released on April 16th and has an FAQ released the next week, 23rd April - this is not valid for use at this event.

A new battletome is released on April 9th and has an FAQ released on the 16th April - this is valid for use at this event

Army lists should be presented in a really easy to read format and include your Grand Strategy, all relevant weapon selections, unit upgrades, spells, relics and artefacts and anything else that isn't a default for a unit. We would prefer all army lists to be created using the Warscroll Builder app, available on the Warhammer-community.com website.

Army lists must be emailed in by Tuesday 19th April by 23:59 to: ben.thehobbyroom@gmail.com.

MODELLING AND PAINTING YOUR ARMY

To ensure each player gets the most enjoyment out of the event we ask all players to play will fully painted and based miniatures to at least a battle ready standard. Check out the Games Workshop requirements for 'battle ready' or ask your local store manager.

Each model must accurately represent its entry on your army list. If you any heavily converted, scratch built or other custom models you must seek permission from the event organiser by emailing: ben.thehobbyroom@gmail.com including photographs and the permission request at least 2 weeks before the event.



— THE GAMES —

SPORTSMANSHIP

All players at the event are expected to display the very best of sportsmanship, which means no slow playing, slow rolling, cheating and such. If you are having an issue during your game please see a TO who will be able to help.

BATTLEPLANS

All battleplans will be randomly determined from the General's Handbook 2021 prior to the tournament and will be released after list submission has closed.

PAIRINGS

Round 1 pairing will be done randomly and viewable as registration closes. Each subsequent round will be paired using the Swiss system based first off a Win - Draw - Loss system and then followed by Tournament points. **If you wish to GRUDGE an opponent for round 1, please contact the TO ahead of the event**

SCENERY

Scenery should be set up each game as listed in the General's Handbook 2021. The players can decide amongst themselves if they want to use the scenery rules, however, if at least one of the players wants to use them, they must then be used.

TOURNAMENT POINTS

The Tournament points 20-0 system will be in play over the course of the event. This means, depending on your victory point differential you'll score a number of tournament points. These are used to calculate matchups and tiebreakers at the end of the event.

SCORING

At the end of each game, players are expected to hand in their score card that was placed on their table with all the 'Final Scoring' boxes filled in.

Gaming rankings will be determined as follows:

- 1ST TIEBREAKER: *Win / Draw / Loss*
- 2ND TIEBREAKER: *Tournament Points*
- 3RD TIEBREAKER: *Kill Points*
- 4TH TIEBREAKER: *Favourite player ranking.*

If after all tiebreakers more than one player have the same ranking, a simple dice roll will determine the victor.

FAVOURITE PLAYER RANKING

At the start of the weekend you'll be given a game record sheet, this is to allow you to keep track of your opponents and armies they played over the course of the event.

Also on this sheet you'll find next to each game a 'Favourite player ranking' section. You need to score your games from 1 to 5, with 5 being your favourite game of the event and 1 being your least favourite

We know that it can be really difficult to just cast your single vote at other events so this is an experimental way to help determine your favourite player ranking. As such, You can only score each value once over the spread of your 5 games. For example: only one game can be awarded a score of 5.



— EVENT AWARDS —

AWARDS

There are a few awards up for grabs over the course of the 2-day event and they are as follows:

TOURNAMENT CHAMPION: *Awarded to the player who ranks 1st over the event.*

FIRST RUNNER-UP: *Awarded to the player who ranks 2nd over the event.*

SECOND RUNNER-UP: *Awarded to the player who ranks 3rd over the event.*

WOODEN SPOON: *Awarded to the player who ranks lowest over the event.*

MOST SPORTING: *Awarded to the player who achieves the most Favourite Player Points.*

BEST PAINTED: *Awarded to the player who received the most best painted votes from the rest of the field.*

TOTAL ANNIHILATOR: *Awarded to the player who has the highest kill points over the event.*

MASTER TACTICIAN: *Awarded to the player who achieves the most battle tactics over the event.*

THE HOARDER: *Awarded to the player who held the most objectives throughout all their games.*

Total Annihilator, Master Tactician and The Hoarder prizes are only available for players outside of the top 3.
